


2024 Infusion Pump Transition Survey






New infusion pump considerations


The last time your health system selected new infusion pumps

Are you considering new smart infusion pumps within the next 2 years?






Reasons for considering new smart infusion pumps

Summary and lessons learned

Summary

- Compatibility with interoperability is the top priority for those considering new infusion pumps
- Alignment of pump types and libraries across health systems is important

Additional feedback and lessons learned

- Create a multidisciplinary team and identify a project lead
- Leverage end user input
- Consider additional costs involved (contractual, fluids, tubing, etc.)
- Ensure pump build matches electronic health record build
- Investigate wireless strength and wireless capabilities of pumps
